



Cheshire County Fish and Game Club High Power National Match Course League*

Match Dates 2011: May 8th, July 10th, October 2nd, 2011

Match Times: Squadding begins at 0730 hours.
Safety Briefing at 0750 hours
Firing begins at 0800 hours

Match Fee: \$10 per match

Eligibility: Open to any individuals, but should be experienced with their rifle and range commands

Course of Fire: Reduced Course NMC, Targets: SR, SR-3, MR-63
200 yds slow fire - Standing - 10 shots - 10 minutes - target SR
200 yds rapid fire – Sitting -10 shots - 60 seconds – target SR
300 yds rapid fire – Prone - 10 shots - 70 seconds – target SR-3
300 yds slow fire - Prone - 20 shots - 20 minutes - target MR-63
Sighting shots: 2 minutes for 2 sighters at each stage of fire

Rules and Regulations:

- Current NRA Highpower rules apply.
- Empty Chamber Indicators (ECI) are required.
- Shooters are required to pull targets and help score for other shooters
- Muzzle down rule while loading will be strictly enforced
- Match Director will appoint a Pit Officer for each relay.
- Scoring will be done in the pits if less than 15 shooters participate

Awards:

- CCF&G T-shirts will be awarded to the Open Winner, High Unclassified and High Score in Each Classification.
- Classifications will be combined for less than 5 shooters in any classification
- The best 2 out of 3 matches will determine final league results.
- A shooter's classification as of the first match will be used for awards.
