## President's Corner

I would like to start by thanking the membership for a great year in 2009. Despite a difficult economy, paired with an ammunition shortage and cost increases, the club still grew to a record membership level of 576 members. We had excellent participation in club cleanup days and improvement efforts. I am confident in saying the club is on a positive roll and is looking the best it ever has.

For 2010 we are planning even more improvements and upgrades to the range. More details can be found within this newsletter. I encourage you all to be more active in the club events as well as its operation. One of my New Year's resolutions was to shoot one of every type of event held in 2010. I will try my hand at trap, long range buffalo shoots as well as archery. I encourage each of you to do the same and I challenge you to bring a new person to the event with you.

If you give the match director a call before hand, they can usually arrange for loaner equipment if you need it.

One of the most important things we are working on in 2010 is our money and cost management. Starting in 2008, the Officers and Board of Directors changed the way in which memberships fees were determined. Previously, income obtained from all sources was lumped together to cover the cost of operating the range as well as any improvements, no formal budgeting process was undertaken. In 2008 we decided to do things a little differently; we started breaking down our expenses into groups:

1. Things that were required to keep the range operating
2. Range improvements
3. Match and event expenses

We sorted our income by:

1. Regular membership fees
2. Orientation fees

3. Match fees
4. Concessions profits
5. Fundraising
6. Donations

Our plan moving forward is to review the membership fees on a yearly basis every February at the board of directors meeting. The idea is to plan for those expenses required to keep the range open and divide that cost across the members of the club. 100% of your membership fee will be used for the operation of the club. All other income from orientation fees, match fees and fundraising will be earmarked for club improvements and future growth.

Two years ago the cost of operating the club was \$23 per member more than the regular membership fees. To counter this, we raised the regular membership rate from \$85 to \$100.

Today, through a combination of cost reductions as well as a record club membership level, I am proud to say that the cost of running the range is balanced against the current membership fees. Therefore, there will be no membership fee increases in 2011.

Thanks again to everyone. I look forward to seeing you out at the range.

## **CCF&G Master Plan**

The Club Improvement Committee is drafting a five year plan for range development. In the upcoming years we are planning to:

- Upgrade the electrical capability of the club by running power to all ranges
- Building a storage garage for equipment and clay pigeon storage
- Adding a 5 Stand system for shotgun events
- Creating additional pistol bay
- Expanding the parking areas
- Refurbishing the cover on the 100 yard smallbore range

Previous work by this committee has included: Member access to the clubhouse, the purchase of a riding lawnmower, WiFi access, keyless entry and the surveillance system

## **SAFETY ISSUE - Rifle Range Flag**

We have had a few instances where people have left the red range flag raised on the 200 yd line after they are done shooting. The flag is required to be up whenever anyone is forward of the firing line. It needs to be put away when the last person returns from down range. If you find the flag in the raised position, it is your responsibility to walk all the way down to the 200 yard berm to ensure that the range is clear before taking down the flag to begin shooting.

**Remember: Safety is everyone's responsibility.**

## **Club-house access**

Beginning with your 2010 club membership, all members will have access to the clubhouse. Inside you can find full restroom facilities as well as vending machines for refreshments and basic safety items. You can access the clubhouse by using the combination listed on your membership card. Please be respectful of the clubhouse by helping to keep it clean and remembering to lock the door on your way out. The clubhouse is currently monitored 24/7 by high-resolution video surveillance, so remember to smile for the cameras.

### **TO OPEN THE CLUBHOUSE FRONT DOOR:**

1. PUSH THE "SCHLAGE" BUTTON
2. ENTER THE 4 DIGIT COMBINATION (SAME # AS FRONT GATE) AND
3. TURN THE KEY KNOB CLOCKWISE  
(IF THE KEY KNOB TURNS HARD-PULL ON THE DOOR HANDLE WHILE TURNING THE KEY KNOB)

### **IF YOU ARE LAST OUT OF THE CLUBHOUSE, YOU MUST LOCK THE DOOR FROM THE OUTSIDE:**

#### **TO LOCK THE DOOR:**

1. WITH ONE HAND-PULL ON THE DOOR KNOB AND HOLD THE DOOR CLOSED TIGHTLY-WITH THE OTHER HAND-PUSH THE "SCHLAGE" BUTTON AND
2. TURN THE KEY KNOB COUNTERCLOCKWISE UNTIL THE DEAD BOLT CLOSSES AND LEAVE THE KEY KNOB IN THE CLOSED POSITION.
3. TRY TO OPEN THE DOOR- IF THE DOOR HAS NOT LOCKED-REPEAT STEPS 1-3 UNTIL LOCKED

In recognition of your service to our country, the Board of Directors is extending Membership to all military personnel as follows:

1. Eligibility: Active duty military: New and Renewal Membership-Free
2. Eligibility: 100% service connected disability-Veterans and Law Enforcement-Free
3. Eligibility: Guard & Reserve (not on call-up/active duty), the first year membership is Free. Renewal of memberships will be discounted to our senior and student rates.

In order to activate your membership, you are required to:

1. Complete a new member application. A current military ID is required.
2. Attend a new member Safety Orientation (approx. 1 hr) held at the CCF&G Clubhouse every Saturday at 1000 hours.
3. New (Active Duty, Guard & Reserve) and renewal of membership (Guard & Reserve only) will be issued only at the CCF&G Clubhouse Saturdays from 1000 – 1300 hrs.
